Instead of building a connector from. Fiber optic pigtails solve this operational bottleneck by shifting the most critical optical interface—the connector—from the unpredictable field to a controlled factory environment. The bare end is fusion-spliced to a trunk or distribution cable inside a splice tray or fiber distribution box. Common types include single-mode OS2, multimode OM3/OM4.
