You can view and configure Fibre Channel ports and port groups on the NAS by going to Storage Manager > iSCSI & Fibre Channel > Fibre Channel > FC Ports. Before creating a Fibre Channel uplink, make sure you have configured the universal ports as FC ports using the steps in the previous Configure Fibre Channel universal ports section. Note:. On the MX9116n FSE, port-group 1/1/15 and 1/1/16 are universal ports capable of connecting to FC devices at various speeds depending on the optic being used.
