Automatic switches transfer power without human intervention, while manual switches require operator action to change the power source. Manual switches, also known as manual transfer switches (MTS) or changeover switches, allow an operator to manually transfer a load from one power source to another. They are simple, cost-effective, and reliable for applications where power interruptions are infrequent or non-critical. The operator physically moves the switch to connect the load to either the primary source (utility) or the backup source (generator) while ensuring both sources remain isolated to prevent backfeeding and electrical hazards. Manual switches are commonly used in small commercial buildings, residential backup systems, or non-critical industrial loads. Automatic switches, often called automatic transfer switches (ATS), are intelligent devices that monitor electrical parameters such as voltage and frequency. When the primary power source fails or falls outside acceptable limits, the ATS automatically transfers the load to an alternate source, such as a generator or secondary utility feed, without human intervention. Once the primary source is restored, the ATS switches the load back. ATS devices can operate in different modes, including: Open Transition (Break-Before-Make): Disconnects the first source before connecting the second, preventing overlap. Closed Transition (Make-Before-Break): Briefly connects both sources to ensure uninterrupted power. Delayed Transition: Introduces a programmed delay to allow stabilization of the alternate source before transfer. Automatic switches are essential in critical facilities like hospitals, data centers, airports, and industrial plants where even brief power interruptions can have severe consequences.
