- 3. Direct Burial:** Direct burial involves placing armored or water-blocked fiber cables directly into trenches. This method is ideal for rural or stable areas with minimal external risk. Burial depth is determined by local regulations, soil stability, frost conditions, and surface activity. Armored cables provide protection against rodents, mechanical stress, and environmental hazards.
- 4. Conduit Installation:** In urban or high-traffic areas, fiber cables are installed inside HDPE or PVC conduits. Conduits protect the cable from moisture, mechanical stress, and future excavation. Proper conduit preparation includes straight, continuous runs with secure joints and avoidance of sharp bends to maintain the fiber's minimum bend radius.
