3. Reducers and Transition Fittings When connecting trays of different widths, reducers are used to transition from a main run to a branch run. These fittings are bolted or clamped to the tray ends, ensuring smooth cable routing without sharp bends.
4. Horizontal and Vertical Bends Horizontal bends (30°, 45°, 90°) and vertical bends (risers) require specialized elbow fittings. These fittings are connected to the straight sections using splice plates or integrated flanges, maintaining structural integrity while allowing directional changes.
5. Tees and Crosses For branching cable runs, T-joints and cross-joints are used. These are bolted to the main tray sections and provide secure pathways for cables to diverge to different areas.
6. Wire Mesh and Channel Tray Connections Wire mesh trays are connected using clamps or specialized mesh connectors that align the mesh edges....
