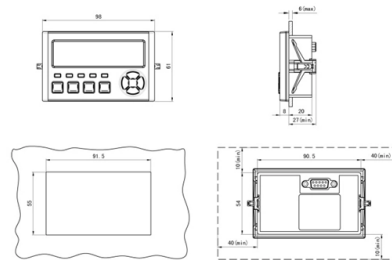


Cable tray cover plate fixing process
