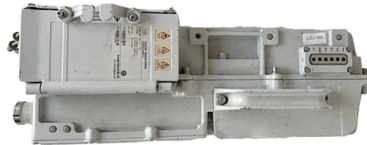


Cable tray noise reduction

A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when. Wrie mesh cable tray is a new type of cable management product, mainly used for the wiring and management of power and communication cables. It is made of steel wire, welded and surface treated to improve its durability and aesthetics. Grid cable tray has high strength, good air permeability. Paragraph 6.
