- Bend Radius and Routing:** Maintain the minimum bend radius for cables as they enter or exit the tray to avoid insulation damage. Ladder-type or ventilated trays allow better airflow, reducing heat buildup in vertical runs.
- Separation of Circuits:** High-power and low-power cables should be segregated to prevent electromagnetic interference (EMI). Vertical trays should follow the same separation rules as horizontal installations.
- Fill Limits:** Do not exceed 40% of the tray's cross-sectional area for power cables and 50% for control cables. Overfilling can compromise airflow and increase temperature, especially in vertical configurations.
- Material Selection:** Choose tray materials (aluminum, steel, or FRP) based on environmental conditions, load requirements, and corrosion resistance. Aluminum is lightweight and corrosion-resistant, while steel provides higher structural strength.
- Accessibility and Maintenance:** Vertical trays must remain accessible for inspection and maintenance...
