As they do not emit electromagnetic signals, they're difficult to tap and secure against eavesdropping. Other than entry level network switches, most of today's network switches include one or more GiBC (Gigabit Converter) or SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) slots. SFP modules insert into these slots and require two strands of fiber, typically duplex. Using multi mode fiber (for runs under 1000.
