- Multimode Fiber (MM):** Not applicable for single-core SM, but for reference, OM1-OM5 with larger cores ($50\text{--}62.5\text{ }\mu\text{m}$) are used for short-distance applications.

Classification by Connector Type

Single-core patch cords can terminate with various connectors:

- SC (Subscriber Connector):** Large, easy to handle, common in FTTH and CATV.
- LC (Lucent Connector):** Smaller, high-density, preferred in data centers.
- FC (Ferrule Connector):** Screw-on type, used in industrial and telecom applications.
- ST (Straight Tip):** Bayonet-style, common in legacy networks.
- E2000:** Spring-loaded shutter for dust protection, high-performance applications.
- Other connectors:** MU, MT-RJ, MPO/MTP for specialized or high-density setups.

Classification by Configuration

- Simplex:** Single fiber, one-way transmission.
- Duplex:** Two fibers, two-way transmission (Tx/Rx), often used in Ethernet and PON links.
