

Color Standard for Stop Lights in Distribution Boxes

IEC 60204-1 recommends black, white, or gray for STOP/OFF indicators, with red reserved for emergency stop, while START/ON indicators are typically white, gray, or black, with green optionally allowed. Standard Color Coding

STOP / OFF Indicators: Preferred colors: Black, White, Gray. Red is permitted only for emergency stop functions. Green should not be used for STOP/OFF actuators. When distinguishing between START/ON and STOP/OFF using only white and black, black is used for STOP/OFF and white for START/ON.

START / ON Indicators: Preferred colors: White, Gray, Black. Green is optionally allowed. Red should not be used for normal START/ON functions. These actuators close switching devices and start equipment.

Emergency Stop: Red is the standard color, often combined with a yellow background to enhance visibility. Only used for emergency stop functions, not for normal STOP/OFF.

Reset Actuators: Colors: Blue, White, Gray, Black. If a reset actuator also functions as STOP/OFF, it should follow the STOP/OFF color rules.

Abnormal Conditions / Alerts: Yellow is used to indicate abnormal conditions, such as automatic cycle interruptions. Red, yellow, blue, and green can be used to attract operator attention for warnings or alerts.

Confirm Command / Status Indicators: Blue and White are typically used to confirm commands or indicate successful operations.

Additional Guidelines: When the same color is used for multiple functions, engraving, symbols, or labels should be added to avoid confusion. These color standards are part of IEC 60204-1, which ensures operator safety, clear identification, and consistency across industrial control panels. Following these standards reduces the risk of misoperation and enhances maintenance efficiency.
