

Configuration Scheme for Private Network Access Switches



AI Overview

A Private Network Access Switch can be configured by creating a private VLAN or private virtual switch, assigning it to devices, and ensuring isolation from external networks.

Configuring a Private VLAN on Physical Switches

Use the Default SDM Template: Ensure the switch uses the default Switch Database Management (SDM) template to balance system resources between Layer 2 entries and unicast routes. If needed, reset with `sdm prefer default`.

Create Primary and Secondary VLANs: Define a primary VLAN and associate secondary VLANs as either isolated or community VLANs.

Assign Ports: Configure ports as promiscuous (can communicate with all secondary VLANs) or isolated (restricted to primary VLAN communication). Avoid using SPAN destination ports or combining 802.1x with port security on private VLAN ports.

Trunking and Aggregation: Use PAgP or LACP only on promiscuous or isolated trunk ports. Configure trunk encapsulation with `switchport trunk encapsulation dot1q` if supported.

Avoid Conflicts: Do not configure fallback bridging or RSPAN VLANs as part of private VLANs.

Configuring a Private Virtual Switch in Hyper-V

Open Hyper-V Manager: Launch Hyper-V Manager and select your host.

Create a Private Switch: Click Virtual Switch Manager, select Private, and click Create Virtual Switch.

Name the Switch: Assign a descriptive name for the private network and click OK.

Assign to Virtual Machines: Edit each VM's network adapter settings, select the newly created private switch, and apply the changes.

IP Configuration: Configure IP addresses for VMs within the private network. No default gateway is required since the VMs cannot access external networks.

Test Connectivity: Verify that VMs can communicate with each other but are isolated from the host and external network.
