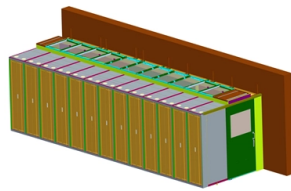

Balance single-phase loads across phases to prevent neutral overloading and ensure stable operation . Check for moisture or dust ingress in connectors, especially in outdoor or wet environments .
