

Construction of cable tray supports in Xunhua

Anchoring: Drill and fix anchors securely into walls or existing structures. Use high-quality fasteners such as Hilti nut bolts for reliable attachment.

Fabrication and Welding: For bridge supports or custom spans, fabricate MS channels and angles, welding them to existing structures as needed. Ensure all welded areas are coated with primer and enamel for corrosion protection.

Tray Installation: Install perforated GI cable trays (e.g., 300 x 50 mm) using high-tensile bolts, washers, and nuts. Use coupler plates for joining tray sections, ensuring proper alignment and electrical continuity.

Isolation and Safety: Place insulating sheets (e.g., G-10 or FRP) at each support to prevent electrical contact with the metal structure. Remove sharp edges and debris to avoid cable damage.
