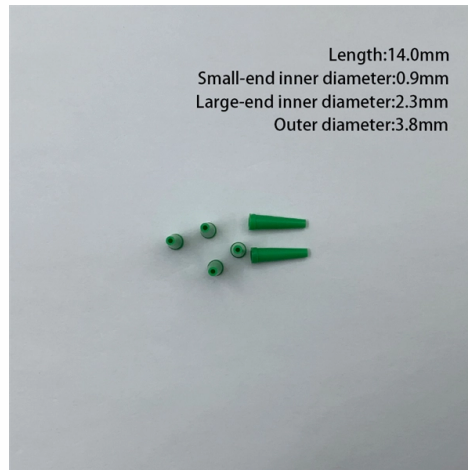


Construction of electrical distribution box in building corridor

Wire Preparation: Strip insulation to the recommended length (usually 10–12mm) and ensure proper conductor exposure.

Circuit Breakers: Install independent breakers according to load requirements, including RCDs or RCBOs if needed.

Termination: Connect line to line, neutral to neutral, and ground to ground, following color coding standards. Use a torque screwdriver to avoid over- or under-tightening, which can cause arcing or heat buildup.

Cable Management: Route wires neatly, secure with cable ties, and leave space for heat dissipation.
