Cables connected to temporary distribution boxes must be properly rated, protected, grounded, and routed to ensure safety and compliance with construction site standards. Cable Selection and Protection Cables used for temporary distribution should be PVC-insulated, armoured, or flexible multi-core cables suitable for the expected load and environmental conditions. For outdoor or rough-use areas, industrial-grade connectors (e.g., CEE or IP67-rated) are recommended to prevent accidental disconnection and protect against dust, moisture, and mechanical damage (). All cables must be terminated correctly and connected to overcurrent protection devices such as fuses or circuit breakers (). Grounding and Safety Each temporary circuit must include a separate equipment grounding conductor, and all receptacles should be of the grounding type. Metal enclosures, raceways, and cable armor must be electrically continuous and bonded to provide effective grounding (). Ground-fault protection (GFCI) is required for circuits supplying temporary power to reduce the risk of electrocution (). Routing and Installation Cables should be routed to minimize obstruction and avoid physical damage. Options include: Suspending cables on racks or poles at a minimum height of 19 ft (5.8 m) for overhead runs (). Burying cables at safe depths (0.2 m for temporary installations) with protective tiles or conduit and marking the route clearly (). Avoiding joints where possible; if unavoidable, use purpose-built housings (). Fastening open conductors at intervals not exceeding 10 ft (3.05 m) (). Temporary Distribution Box Requirements Temporary distribution boxes should be portable, impact-resistant, and weatherproof, with clearly labeled circuits and integrated grounding and protection devices (). They must allow easy disconnection of all ungrounded conductors via a switch or plug connector to isolat...
