NEC and Mounting Requirements According to NEC Article 312, outdoor boxes must be rain-tight (minimum NEMA 3R) and surface-mounted to prevent water ingress. The front edge of the box should be set back no more than 1/4 inch from the finished wall surface for noncombustible walls, and flush or slightly projecting for combustible surfaces. Boxes must also provide adequate space for wire bending, typically adding 1 inch clearance beyond the bus or breaker depth to allow safe conductor routing. Material and Environmental Considerations Outdoor boxes are usually made of corrosion-resistant metal or UV-resistant plastic to withstand environmental exposure. For coastal or chemically aggressive environments, NEMA 4X enclosures are recommended.
