- Standards and Ratings:** Ensure the box complies with NEC, IEC, or local electrical codes. Consider IP or NEMA ratings for environmental protection, especially for outdoor or industrial installations.

Typical Dimensions:

- Residential DBs:** Width 12-18 inches, height 12-24 inches, depth 4-6 inches.
- Commercial/Industrial DBs:** Width 18-36 inches, height 24-48 inches, depth 6-12 inches, depending on the number of circuits and amperage.
