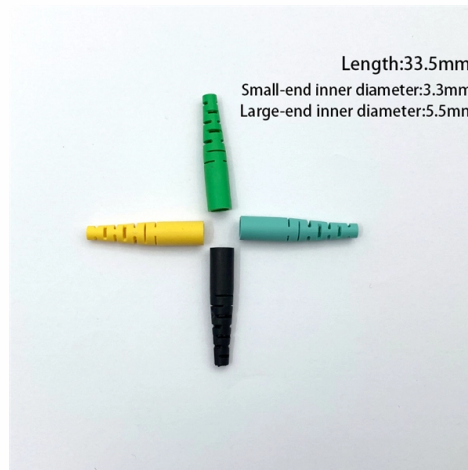


Distribution Box Neutral and Live Wire Connection Method

Directly connecting the live wire to the neutral wire in a distribution box is extremely dangerous and should never be done. Use single-pole MCBs for individual circuits, connecting the live wire to the MCB and the neutral wire to the neutral bus bar. Ensure the earth wire is connected to the earth bus bar for safety. Label all circuits and verify wire sizes according to load requirements to prevent overheating or voltage drops. Only qualified electricians should perform modifications inside a distribution box.
