

Distribution box neutral and live wire connection terminals



Overview

When wiring, connect the neutral wire to the N terminal, and connect the unmarked terminal to the live wire. Live (L) Wire Connection: In a distribution box setup, the incoming live wire (also known as phase or hot wire, denoted as L or Line) connects to the line terminal of the circuit breaker. This serves as the primary source of electrical energy from the mains supply. In a specific point. A neutral link is used to distribute a neutral supply to all the output loads. The Main feeder cable to the Distribution Board should be able to handle the total power anticipated when all the sub circuits in the Distribution Board. A consumer unit (CU) also known as panel box, breaker box or fuse box is a type of a distribution board (aka electric panel, breaker panel, panelboard or main breaker-box or main service panel) which is used to distribute and fed the electric power to the sub-circuits and final sub-circuits.
