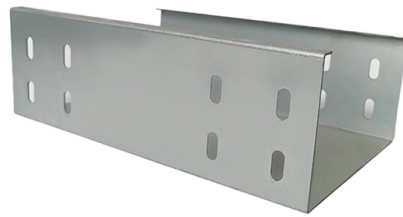

Avoid Jumper Wires: Directly connecting one breaker to another with a wire (jumper) is prohibited because the first wire may carry the sum of currents from all downstream breakers, risking overheating and fire (). Follow Line Sequence: For three-phase systems, ensure correct phase alignment (R-R, S-S, T-T, N-N) when connecting wires to the busbars or terminals (). Secure Connections: Strip the insulation properly (typically 10–12 mm), insert the wire into the terminal, and tighten screws to the recommended torque (e.g., 4.0 N·m for EPS ports) to ensure a reliable connection (). Grounding: Connect the ground wire from the chassis to the ground busbar using a dedicated cable to maintain safety (). Safety Considerations Overcurrent Risk: Improper parallel connections can cause wires to carry excessive current, leading to overheating and potential fire hazards (). Compliance: National electrical standards explicitly prohibit jumper connections in distribution boxes to ensure safe and reliable operation (). Circuit Breaker Type: Ensure correct wiring for 1P or 2P breakers. For 1P breakers, the neutral bypasses the breaker; for 2P breakers, both live and neutral are controlled ().
