

Do cable trays need fireproof partitions when passing through walls



Overview

When cable trays pass through walls or floors, seal openings using fire-rated penetration sealing materials. Do not modify or damage the tray coating or structure during use. Process flow: reserved openings → busway installation → distribution box positioning and installation →. Install fire barriers within the tray to isolate different fire zones. A through-penetration firestop system is a specific field-erected construction of an assemblage of materials designed to prevent the spread of fire and its byproducts for a prescribed period of time through openings which are made in floors and walls to accommodate through penetrating items such as. To bring a wall or floor back up to its original fire rating, UL-tested and -certified firestopping materials must be installed around the pipes, HVAC ducts, cables, cable trays, and other penetrants going through the hole.
