Without electricity powering these components, the fiber optic system cannot function, and data transmission stops even though the fiber itself remains intact. Special Cases: Hybrid Cables Some fiber optic cables, like OPGW (Optical Power Ground Wire) or OPPC (Optical Power Phase Conductor), are installed alongside electrical power lines. In these cases, the cable may be physically attached to conductors carrying electricity, but the optical fibers inside remain electrically isolated and are unaffected by the electrical current.
