Installation and Safety Pole-mounted distribution boxes are engineered for durability and weather resistance, often featuring lockable covers and insulated enclosures. They are typically installed at a height that allows safe access for maintenance while keeping the equipment out of reach of the public. Proper installation ensures reliable power delivery and minimizes the risk of electrical hazards.

- Circuit breakers or fuses for overload protection
- Busbars for connecting multiple circuits
- Insulated terminals to prevent accidental contact
- Optional smart monitoring devices for energy management and predictive maintenance
