Overview of the Three-Level System

In a typical building electrical system, power from the transformer's low-voltage side (0.4kV) is distributed through a three-tier hierarchy:

- Primary Distribution Box (Main Distribution Board, MDB)** Acts as the central hub for the entire site or building complex. Directly connected to the transformer, delivering 0.4kV power. Does not supply power directly to end-use equipment. Contains isolating switches, circuit breakers, and residual current devices (RCDs) to ensure overall circuit safety. Designed for outdoor or construction site use with rainproof tops and durable construction.
- Secondary Distribution Box (Sub-Distribution Board, SDB)** Serves specific buildings, floors, or zones. Distributes three-phase power to intermediate loads such as motors or heavy equipment. Equipped with larger three-phase circuit breakers and protective features like dual-door protection and powder-coated exteriors. Ensures safety during intermediate stages and may include RCDs for zone-level protection.
- Tertiary Distribution Box (Final Distribution Box, DB or Switch Box)** Connects directly to end-use equipment or household systems, supplying 220V single-phase power. Implements strict safety standards: “one device, one circuit breaker, one RCD, one box”, ensuring independent protection for each device. Can be fixed or portable, allowing flexible installation and adherence to a two-layer protection strategy (RCDs at both tertiary and secondary levels). Designed to prevent electrical hazards and provide local control for individual appliances.
