Proper grounding of an electrical distribution box enclosure ensures safety by preventing electric shock and providing a low-resistance path for fault currents. Why Ground the Enclosure Grounding the enclosure is essential because all metallic parts, including the cabinet body and doors, must be bonded to ground to prevent electric shock from accidental contact or fault currents. Even if the cabinet body is grounded, metal doors can accumulate static charge or become live if a wire inside touches them, so they require a dedicated ground connection according to NEC 250.148 and 314.28 standards. Grounding Materials and Wire Use a copper core wire with yellow-green insulation for visibility and safety. In the US, a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) ground wire is standard, while other markets may require 6 mm². Ensure the wire has sufficient cross-sectional area to maintain a low-resistance path (

Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.
