- Install Protective Devices** Connect each appliance circuit to its dedicated MCB or RCBO. Include fuses or surge protectors where necessary to prevent overloads or short circuits.
- Connect Live, Neutral, and Earth Wires** Live (phase) wires go to the input terminal of the MCB. Neutral wires connect to the neutral bar. Earth wires connect to the earth bar or RCBO earth terminal.
- Label Circuits** Clearly label each circuit with the appliance or area it serves. This simplifies maintenance and troubleshooting.
- Testing Before Power-On** Perform visual inspections to ensure no loose connections. Use a multimeter to check continuity, voltage, and proper ground...
