Network Architecture

FTTH and PON Designs: For point-to-multipoint networks, passive optical networks (PON) use splitters to share a single fiber among multiple premises. The Optical Line Terminal (OLT) at the central office connects to Optical Network Units (ONUs) or Terminals (ONTs) at user premises via optical distribution networks (ODN), which include splitters and connectors .

Splitter placement and fiber levels (Level-1, Level-2, drop cables) are critical for minimizing signal loss and ensuring efficient coverage .

Active Optical Networks (AON): In AON, each user has a dedicated fiber connection to a switch, providing full bi-directional communication over distances up to 80 km . This architecture allows precise bandwidth management and easier troubleshooting.
