- Organizing cables:** Prevents tangling and clutter, ensuring easy identification and routing of fibers.
- Protecting fibers:** Safeguards fragile strands from physical damage and environmental factors.
- Facilitating maintenance:** Simplifies troubleshooting, moves, adds, and changes (MACs) without disrupting active services.
- Supporting scalability:** Modular and high-density panels allow network expansion without major rework.
