The connector end is polished and tested under factory conditions to ensure low insertion loss and high return loss, while the bare end is intended for fusion or mechanical splicing to a fiber optic cable in the field. This design allows for fast, reliable, and cost-effective terminations in patch panels, optical distribution frames (ODFs), or terminal boxes.

Connector Types and Fiber Modes Pigtails come in various connector types to match network equipment:

- SC: Durable snap-in design, widely used in telecom and data applications
- LC: Small form-factor, ideal for high-density installations
- ST: Bayonet-style, often in older multimode networks
- FC: Screw-on, secure for high-vibration environments

They are also available in single-mode (OS2) for long-distance, high-bandwidth applications, and multimode for shorter distances. Polishing options include UPC and APC, affecting return loss performance.
