

Fiber optic cable is working but the switch is not

Fiber optic cables may fail to connect due to SFP incompatibility, incorrect polarity, dirty connectors, or physical damage. Check SFP and Cable Compatibility. Dust, oil, or debris on fiber connectors can block the signal. Use lint-free wipes and isopropyl alcohol to clean both ends of the fiber. Inspect for visible damage, bends, or broken connectors. Even minor contamination can prevent the link from establishing. Test Physical Layer and Hardware. Check port LEDs on the switch; a red or amber light indicates a problem. Swap the fiber cable with a known-good cable to rule out cable defects. Test SFPs by replacing them with known-good units. Bypass patch panels or media converters if used, to isolate the fault. Verify Configuration. Ensure the switch port is enabled and not administratively shut down. Confirm that the speed and duplex settings match on both ends, especially for multigigabit links. Use Diagnostic Tools. If the problem persists, use an OTDR (Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer) or a power meter to measure signal loss and locate breaks or faults in the fiber. By systematically checking SFP compatibility, fiber polarity, connector cleanliness, physical integrity,...
