

Fiber optic module damaged switch port

- Cleaning** Use lint-free wipes or isopropyl alcohol to clean LC connectors. Recheck optical power after cleaning to confirm improvement.
- Testing Optical Performance** Use an optical power meter to measure TX and RX levels. Compare readings to module specifications to identify weak or lost signals.
- Switch Diagnostics** Use CLI commands (e.g., show interfaces transceiver detail, show logging) to check module status, detected errors, and optical power levels. Verify firmware compatibility and vendor support for the module.
- Reseating or Replacing the Module** Power off the switch if required by the manufacturer. Release the latch and carefully remove the module to avoid port damage. Reseat the module or replace it with a known-good transceiver if issues persist. Check Fiber Path Confirm correct patch panel connections and polarity. Use a visual fault locator to detect breaks or discontinuities in the fiber run.
