Values outside the typical range of -15 dBm to -30 dBm may indicate excessive loss or a break in the fiber. OTDR testing can also help locate the exact point of failure along the fiber link.

Step 4: Check Configuration Verify that network settings, IP addresses, and routing configurations are correct. Misconfigured devices or firmware issues can prevent signal recognition even if the physical connection is intact. Ensure the correct fiber type and connector polarity are used, especially for MPO or multi-fiber connections.
