Topologies Fibre Channel supports three main topologies: Point-to-Point: Direct connection between two devices; simplest configuration. Arbitrated Loop (FC-AL): Devices share a loop, allowing up to 127 ports without a fabric switch; widely used in disk drives. Fabric: Uses a fabric switch to connect devices; supports simultaneous communication among up to 224 devices. Protocol Mapping FC drives often use the FC-4 layer to map upper-layer protocols like SCSI (FCP-SCSI), IP (FC-IP), or VI (FC-VI), enabling compatibility with existing storage protocols. While traditionally associated with optical fiber, many FC HDDs use copper twisted-pair cables for cost-effective connections in disk arrays.
