These inserts are particularly effective in gypsum wall assemblies and can provide 1- to 2-hour fire ratings, making them suitable for both metallic and non-metallic boxes.

Protective Coatings and Putty Pads Another method involves fire-resistant coatings or putty pads applied to metallic electrical boxes, especially recessed or larger boxes. These materials are tested and listed to maintain the fire-resistance rating of walls or ceilings where the boxes are installed. Membrane firestop systems with appropriate F and T ratings ensure that penetrations do not compromise the fire-resistance of the assembly.
