- Indication Lights:** Some modern DB boxes include lights to show the status of mains power or individual circuits.
- Labels and Circuit Identification:** Each breaker or fuse is typically labeled to indicate the circuit it controls, aiding in troubleshooting and maintenance.

Safety Features The front panel is designed to prevent accidental contact with live parts. In North American panels, the breakers are operable from the front, but live busbars are enclosed behind insulating barriers. In Canadian service panels, the main switch is separated so that turning it off exposes no live parts during servicing. UK consumer units also follow similar safety standards, incorporating protective devices and clear separation of live, neutral, and earth conductors.

- Turn circuits on or off safely.
- Reset tripped breakers.
- Monitor power status through indicators.
- Access emergency shut-off via the main switch.
