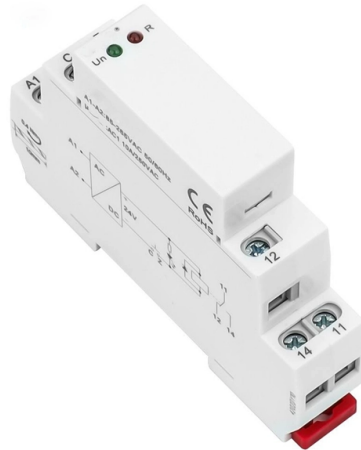

They often comply with IP (Ingress Protection) ratings to prevent dust and water ingress and may include glow wire testing to ensure fire resistance. Internal components such as circuit breakers, fuses, busbars, and isolators are safely enclosed, and PVC insulating sleeves are used for phase identification and additional safety.
