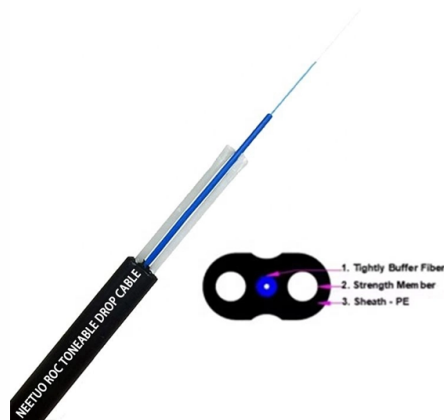


Home electrical distribution box outgoing wires coiled
