Avoid bending fiber cables beyond manufacturer recommendations to prevent attenuation or microfractures. Multimode fiber optic switches can handle multiple input and output ports, supporting simplex or duplex connections, and may use MEMS or liquid crystal technology for fast, reliable switching.
