Standard copper wiring is limited to about 1,200 meters (4,000 feet) at 100 kbps, and is susceptible to electromagnetic interference (EMI). Fiber optic cabling overcomes these limitations by converting electrical RS-485 signals into optical signals, allowing long-distance, EMI-immune communication (). Common connector types: ST, SC, FC. Power Considerations Fiber optic cabling carries communication only, not power. Remote devices like keypads or repeaters require separate power supplies (). Installation Guidelines Topology: RS-485 networks are typically linear (bus) but can include star configurations using hubs or splitters. Fiber allows point-to-point or star connections with converters (). Termination: Proper termination resistors are recommended to prevent reflections and data errors. Distance Extension: Using fiber, RS-485 networks can extend from 1.2 km (copper) to up to 45 km with single-mode fiber and appropriate converters (). EMI Protection: Fiber optic links are immune to EMI, making them ideal for industrial environments with high-voltage equipment or variable freq...
