

How to distribute current in a distribution box

Connect the Main Supply The incoming phase and neutral wires are connected to the main breaker. This breaker should be rated for the total current capacity of the system ().

Use Busbars for Power Distribution Busbars carry current from the main breaker to individual branch circuit breakers. Ensure that busbars are sized to handle the maximum expected current without overheating ().

Branch Circuit Allocation Each branch circuit is connected to a single-pole or double-pole MCB depending on the load type. Single-pole MCBs are used for standard lighting and socket circuits, while double-pole MCBs are used for high-power or special loads ().

Balance the Load Distribute high-power loads evenly across different breakers to prevent overloading a single circuit. This ensures that current is shared proportionally and reduces the risk of tripping ().

Neutral and Earth Connections Connect all neutral wires to the neutral bar and all protective earth wires to the earth bar. This maintains proper return paths and safety during faults ().

Follow Current Division Principles In parallel circuits, current divides according to the resistance of each path. Lower-resistance circuits c...
