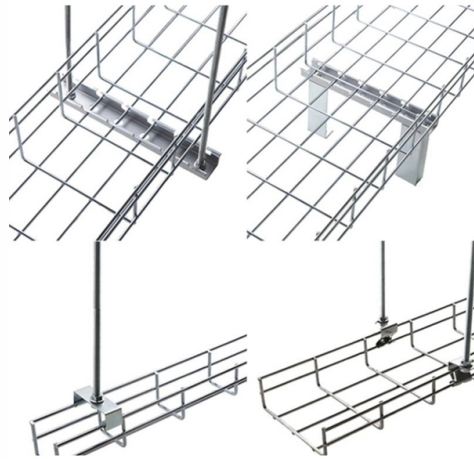


How to ground the wiring of an indoor electrical distribution box

Component Grounding: Any internal electrical components that require grounding should also be connected to the PE bar using copper wires. This ensures all parts share a common ground reference.

Box-to-Mounting Plate: For metal enclosures, attach a ground wire from the box or mounting plate to the central grounding point of the facility.

Resistance Requirements The total ground resistance should be very low to allow fault currents to safely trip protective devices. For industrial applications, the resistance between system parts should be less than 0.1 ohm, and the connection to the main earth ground should be well below 25 ohms. This ensures that in case of a fault, the current flows safely to ground, preventing electric shock or fire.

Hardware and Termination **Grounding Lugs:** Compression lugs can secure the ground wire to the backpanel or enclosure stud.

Grounding Bars/Terminals: Use a dedicated bar or terminal block for multiple ground connections, typically mounted on the metal bac...
