- Identify Overloaded Circuits:** Reduce the load on circuits with multiple devices and see if the breaker resets.
- Inspect Earth Leakage Circuit Breakers (ELCBs):** Faulty ELCBs can trip unexpectedly; test and replace if necessary.
- Tighten Connections:** Loose terminals can cause arcing and overheating; ensure all connections are secure.

Advanced Techniques For complex or hidden faults, such as in underground or concealed wiring, cable fault locators or time domain reflectometry (TDR) can help pinpoint the exact location of the fault.
