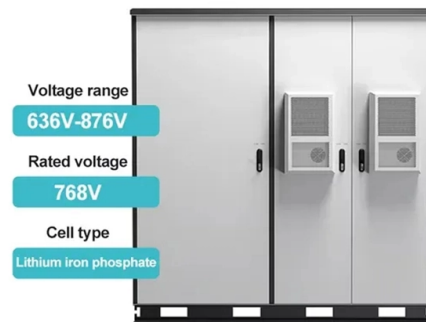


How to install fiber optic cables

 - Conduits and Innerducts:** Protect cables from physical damage and moisture.
 - Pulling:** Fiber is pulled through conduits using tension-controlled equipment.
 - Blowing:** Compressed air propels the fiber through ducts, ideal for long distances.
- 3. Indoor Installation** Fiber patch cords and distribution cables are installed in data centers, racks, or cabinets. Requires careful handling to avoid lateral forces and bending beyond minimum bend radius. Termination involves fusion or mechanical splicing to connect fibers to network equipment.
- 4. Submarine or Specialized Outdoor Installation** Cables are laid underwater or in harsh outdoor environments. Protective armoring and specialized routing prevent damage from water pressure, marine activity, or environmental hazards.
