

How to install the arched elbow of the cable tray

- Fasten the Sections** Use splice plates, nuts, bolts, and washers to secure the elbow to the adjoining straight tray sections. Apply cold galvanizing spray to exposed metal to prevent corrosion ().
- Mount the Tray** Install the tray on supports such as wall-mounted cantilever arms or ceiling-mounted trapeze hangers. Ensure supports are spaced according to load requirements, typically 1.5–3 meters apart, and that the tray is level and straight ().
- Final Checks** Verify that the elbow is properly aligned...
