

How to lay fiber optic cables in a vertical shaft



Overview

Drop vertical cables down rather than pulling them up whenever possible. Sinohydro, a Chinese state-owned hydropower engineering and construction company, wanted to install fiber optic cables through a vertical shaft 500 meters deep.
