

How to match optical cable hardware

Identify Connector Types The first step is to identify the connector types on your devices and cables. Common connectors include:

- Fiber Mode:** Single-mode (OS2) or multimode (OM3/OM4/OM5) must match between cable and device to avoid signal degradation.
- Polish Type:** UPC (Ultra Physical Contact) and APC (Angled Physical Contact) are not interchangeable; APC connectors have an angled end-face to reduce return loss, while UPC connectors are flat.

Use Adapters for Incompatibilities If connectors differ, fiber optic adapters can bridge incompatible types while maintaining alignment. For example, LC-to-SC adapters allow connection between LC and SC cables without signal loss. Always ensure the adapter matches the polish type (UPC or APC) to prevent reflection issues.

Consider Media Converters When connecting different media types (e.g., copper to fiber), media converters are used. Ensure the converter supports the same transmission standards, data rates, and SFP modules as your network equipment. Proper placement in a stable, ventilated location is also important for reliable operation.

Verify Cable Geometry and Assembly

- Simplex vs Duplex:** Duplex cables carry two fibers for bidirectional communication; simplex carries one.
- Cable Diameter:** Common sizes are 0.9 mm, 2.0 mm, or 3.0 mm; ensure compatibility with...
