

How to power on a construction site s high-voltage distribution box

- 5. Power-On Sequence** Close all outgoing circuit breakers before energizing the main breaker. Switch on the main breaker to energize the distribution box. Gradually switch on individual circuits to avoid sudden load spikes. Monitor for abnormal sounds, sparks, or tripping of protective devices.
- 6. Ongoing Safety Measures** Keep the area around the distribution box clear of debris and water. Regularly inspect cables, connectors, and breakers d...
