This helps prevent sudden surges and allows you to monitor for any immediate faults or unusual behavior. For 120V circuits, use single-pole breakers; for 240V circuits, use double-pole breakers connected to both hot busbars. Verify Power Distribution Once all breakers are on, check that power is reaching outlets, lights, and appliances. If any breaker trips immediately, turn it off and investigate the cause before attempting to reset it. Additional Safety Features Modern distribution boxes may include RCDs (Residual Current Devices) that cut power if a leakage is detected.
