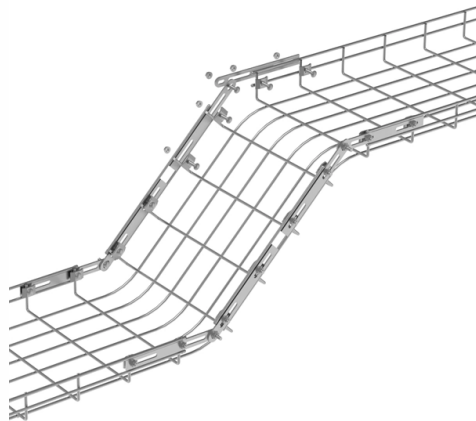


How to press the electrical box in a household
